





## >>Can parents watch the class?

We have found that our students focus better in class and learn more when they can be in the studio without any distractions. We have a variety of strategies and processes to help ease separation anxiety. Parents are welcome to wait in our comfortable waiting room.

>>How do we pay?

You will be emailed a bill for each term which will need to be paid in full before the term begins. You can pay via online transfer, or in person at the studio. We accept cash or card. For those who are unable to pay the full amount in advance, direct debit recurring payments can be set up.

>>What happens if we join and my child decides they don't want to do it anymore? At this young age, it's normal for kids to try different activities. Our billing system works per 10 week term, so if your child no longer wants to do dancing you can finish out the term and let us know at the studio (by filling out a class change or cancellation form) so we can cancel the enrolment on our system. There is no cancellation fee.

# >>What happens if my child misses a class?

It's no problem. We have multiple sessions in the weekly schedule, so your child can attend any of the other classes as a makeup lesson Just let us know.

# >>What do they wear?

Your gorgeous Ballerina can choose whatever ballet clothes they wish although ballet shoes must be worn in class.

#### >>Are there any extra costs?

There is a costume levy of \$1.50 per week which will cover your child's costume hire this is invoiced with your fees . Apart from your dance fees, and concert costume there are no other costs until Term 4, at which point there will be a concert performers fee of \$89 (which will include a t-shirt, medal, concert DVD and professional photo.)

## >>How many kids are there in each class?

This will vary depending on the teacher, and which room the class is held in. Most of our classes will have less than 15 students. We want to make sure that every child has the best possible dancing experience at Soul Dance Studios and gets plenty of interaction with the teachers.
